



Whole School Questionnaire Evaluation: Summer 2019

- ✓ **59 parents / carers completed the questionnaire.**
- ✓ **132 children completed the questionnaire.**
- ✓ **Overwhelming response of strongly agree and agree from both parents and children.**
- ✓ **11/11 questions for parents were above 90% for strongly agree and agree – with 6 questions being 100% (children make good progress, are well looked after and well taught; school deals effectively with bullying and responds well with concerns raised and it is well led and managed).**
- ✓ **10/11 questions for children were above 80% for strongly agree and agree (behaviour question was 73%).**
- ✓ **98% of parents and 84% of children would recommend Eureka Primary School to another parent / child.**

- **16% of children aren't happy; 11% don't feel safe; 14% don't think they are well looked after; 13% don't think we deal with their worries and 15% don't understand how well they are doing in their learning.**
- **Behaviour question for children was 27% for disagree and strongly disagree.**
- **Bullying question for children was 21% for disagree and strongly disagree.**

ACTIONS FOR 2019 – 2020:

- **Autumn 1 teachers assemblies, on a Thursday, to focus on bullying – what it is; how we recognise it; strategies for what to do; ensure clear understanding for all children (this will include an anti-bullying leaflet for children written by the children).**
- **Some of Autumn term's PSHE lessons to focus on expectations; behaviour expectations; behaviour choices and an understanding of different children's needs (including that adults make choices about behaviour that the other children aren't informed about) so there is a clearer understanding. This should also include learning about dyslexia, autism, ADHD as well as anxiety and mental health.**
- **Posters created for what to do if you are unhappy, don't feel safe, are worried etc and displayed in classrooms and around school.**
- **Ensure midday staff understand expectations from them as well as the children: listening, being calm, being respectful and ensuring there is positive interaction with the children and games / activities are being facilitated.**
