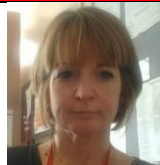




INCLUSION NEWSLETTER

SEND PARENT SURVEY RESULTS

- 85% of SEND parents felt their child was happy at school
- 90% of SEND parents know who the SENDCO is and who to contact if concerned
- 85% of parents know where to find SEND info on the school website
- 70% of SEND parents can see the progress the child is making
- 80% of SEND parents have confidence in the leadership of SEND within school
- 85% of SEND parents feel the school gives me support and offers advice on how I can support my child at home
- 85% of SEND parents are involved in my child's reviews
- 90% of SEND parents receive copies of their child's targets and am aware of what they are working on.
- 50% of parents said they would be interested in termly coffee mornings to meet other parents of SEND pupils
- 65% said they would be interested in attending sessions about the different areas of SEND
- 50% were aware of the schools resources that could be borrowed
- 50% of SEND parents had accessed the resources in school
- 85% of parents would access resources if they were available on the school website
