Why do you think that? • What characters do you think might be in this text? <p>Connecting</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What do you already know about the topic of this text? • Does this topic remind you of anything you know or have done? <p>Questioning</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What questions do you have about this text by looking at the cover? • What do you want to learn? <p>Inferring</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What do you think is the purpose of the book? 	<p>Literary Elements</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Who are the main characters? • What is the problem in the book? • What are sequence of events in the story so far? • What point of view is the story written in? <p>Predicting</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What do you predict will happen next? Why? • What do you predict the character will do next? <p>Inferring</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What do you infer (think) the character might be feeling in this story? <p>Visualizing</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What are you visualizing (picturing) in your head? <p>Connecting</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What does this story make you think of? • Has anything like this ever happened to you? • What would you do if you were a character in this story? • How would you feel if you were a character in this story? • Are you like/different than this character? How? <p>Questioning</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What questions do you have while reading? 	<p>Literary Elements</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Who were the characters in the story? • Describe the setting of the story (use your 5 senses). • What was the problem in the story? How was it solved? <p>Summarizing (Retell)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In your own words, retell what happened in the beginning? middle? ending? <p>Inferring</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What was the main idea or message of the text? • What details support the main idea of the text? <p>Opinion</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What part that you liked or disliked? Why? • Which of the characters did you like best? Why? <p>Connecting</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What did this story make you think about? • What would you have done if you were a character in the story? <p>Compare/Contrast</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Describe how a character changed throughout the book. • How is this book like or different from another book. <p>Predicting</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Did the story end how you thought? • If this story continued, what do you think would happen? <p>Determining Importance</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What do you think was the most important part of this text? 	<p>Who? person or character</p> 	<p>What? things or actions</p> 	<p>Where? a place</p> 	<p>When? a time</p> 	<p>Why? purpose or reason</p> 	<p>How? by what means in what way</p>
