## Weekly Update and Information

Hi All

I hope you have been surviving the heat and you and your family are well.

The children have been really good this week, especially when outside. They have worn hats, applied sunscreen and stayed in the shade...they have also enjoyed ice pops! We will be back in school full time on Monday.

Investigators will be sharing their music and flute playing in an assembly on Thursday, 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 9.00am in the hall. Investigator parents / carers are invited to this, two adults per child please.

There will be no parent morning for Explorers, Investigators and Enquirers due to the assembly.

It is the film and pyjama evening on Thursday, 2<sup>nd</sup> July, after school. We require a slip returned for children to be able to stay. Pyjamas and slippers need to be brought into school in the morning.

A letter re sports day has been sent out this week and today a letter re our family picnic on the last day is being sent out. Please return slips as soon as possible to help with organisation etc. We will be teaching our relationship, sex and health education in the next couple of weeks, the letters for this will be sent next week.

In September, we will have the Investigators and Enquirers classes in the new build. Adventurers, Thinkers and Explorers will be in the main building. As we are growing, our pupil admission number in Reception is now 30. This means the arrangement of classes next year is different and will change over the next couple of years as we expand. In September we will have the following classes:

Adventurers = Reception

Thinkers = Years 1 and 2 We have a new teacher joining our team, Miss Nickless, teaching Thinkers.

Explorers = Years 2 and 3

Investigators = Years 4 and 5

Enquirers = Years 5 and 6

An email is being sent today informing you of which class your child will be in and with which teacher in September, ready for transition morning on Tuesday.

Dates for next year have slightly changed when we return in September. Friday 4<sup>th</sup> September is now a closure day so we can move into the new building, set up classrooms and sort classrooms in the main building. Monday 7<sup>th</sup> September is now our INSET day. Children return to school on Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> September. Please find attached the term dates for 2026 – 2027.
