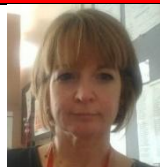




INCLUSION NEWSLETTER

More things to ask you child at the end of the day

Here are some more ideas to encourage your child to talk at the end of the day and share what they have been doing:

- Rate your day on a scale from 1-10.
- How were you brave today?
- What questions did you ask at school today?
- Tell us your top two things from the day (before you can be excused from the dinner table!).
- What are you looking forward to tomorrow?
- What was the hardest rule to follow today?
- Teach me something I don't know.
- If you could change one thing about your day, what would it be?
- What made your teacher smile?
- What kind of person were you today?

BAKING activity

I really enjoy baking with my children so thought I would share a recipe with you in case this was something you would like to try with your child!! Please send me pictures if you have a go - I would love to see them! This recipe was taken from the TESCO website and the flapjacks can be made in the microwave so its even easier when making them with the children!

MICROWAVE APPLE FLAPJACK

Ingredients

- 100g porridge oats
- 1 banana, finely mashed
- 1 apple (about 120g), unpeeled, grated
- 1 tbsp finely milled flaxseed
- ½ tsp ground cinnamon
- 100ml whole milk



Method

Put all the ingredients into a 12 x 20cm microwave-proof container and stir together.

Microwave on high for 4-5 mins until it feels firm to the touch. Allow to cool completely in the container, then use a spatula to remove and slice into 12 pieces.

Tip: The flapjacks will keep in an airtight container for up to 3 days.

Freezing and defrosting guidelines

Freeze in an airtight container for up to 1 month. Defrost at room temperature.
