The order of the family picnic will be as follows:

- 12.45 – 2.15pm: Stalls, games and ice cream van open for all to enjoy and have fun
- 2.20pm: Classes to leave the field to go back into school
- 2.30pm: School finishes, children leave via their usual end of the school day exits
