Hi All

I hope all is well and you have had a good week.

Next Thursday, 3rd July, it is the cinema pyjama evening after school. Children need to bring in their pyjamas (please ensure they are appropriate and also cool if the weather is hot) and slippers. The children will change at 3.00pm for films to start at 3.15pm. Drinks and snacks will be provided. Please pick up your child at 5.00pm from their usual exit.

Please contact the school office when your child is absent or has an appointment. Class emails should not be used for this because it is the office who deal with absences and record these. Appointments should ideally be made for outside of school hours if possible please.

It has been brought to school's attention, on a few occasions in the last week, that there are issues with parking around school and adults have been arguing loudly / aggressively, this is in front of children, and also having a go at children passing by / in between cars. This is not ok and not what we want for our children, parents / carers and community. It is very concerning and a real worry that someone, which could be a child, is going to get seriously hurt, which I am sure we can all agree on that we do not want this to happen.

WE MUST ENSURE THAT CHILDREN AND ADULTS ARE SAFE TO WALK HOME AND CROSS ROADS. WE MUST ENSURE THAT CARS ARE PARKED SAFELY AND ABIDING BY THE HIGHWAY CODE AND PARKING LAWS.

If there are issues in the community re parking, it is Civil Enforcement Officers (CEOs) who deal with this. The enforcement of parking offences such as school zig zags / double yellows etc, are enforced by the CEOs alongside the following list: limited waiting bays; double and single yellow lines; on street pay and display bays; residents' parking zones; Blue Badge bays; loading bays; bus stops; taxi bays; school keep clears; clearways; dropped kerb access (also police); double parking (also police); pedestrian crossings (also police); car parks (with orders).

To report issues that the Civil Enforcement Officers enforce such as double yellows or school zig zags, please report direct via email: contactcentre@derbyshire.gov.uk or by calling: 01629 533190.

The police are responsible for enforcing: double white lines; obstruction – for example, pavements with no parking restrictions; dangerous parking where there are no restrictions in place, for example, on bends, brows of hills and junctions; dropped kerb access (also CEOs); double parking (also CEOs); one-way traffic; box junctions; access only white-hatched areas; pedestrian crossings (also CEOs).
